Dear Parents,

Mount Michael textbooks and classroom materials are handled in several different ways. Below you will find an explanation of each method to help clarify Book Fee and Lab Fee charges.

Elkhorn Textbook Loan: Many of our textbooks for core classes are on loan from the Elkhorn Public Schools. Through this program, we receive textbooks from Elkhorn Public Schools for our students. On the Book List, these textbooks are noted in blue print and will be given to your son by classroom teachers at the beginning of the school year. Last January, you should have signed the paperwork for our agreement with EPS so that your son can participate in this program at no cost to you.

Classroom Book Sets: When textbooks are not available through the Textbook Loan Program, some teachers choose to purchase one classroom set for students to use in class. A small fee may be charged to purchase these sets. This way, your son has access to the books he needs without having to purchase an expensive textbook.

Novel Fees: The curriculum for all English classes include several novels which are purchased by Mount Michael and distributed in class. English fees are assigned to cover the novels required for classes.

Lab Fees: Lab fees are assigned to cover supplies for some classes. The lab fees cover supplies or services needed for specific classes. These fees apply to all art classes, some science classes, computer classes and drafting classes.

Consumable materials fee: Consumable materials are assigned a fee. This includes workbooks that will be distributed in class.

Student Purchased Textbooks: Unless otherwise designated on the Book List, students are required to purchase their own textbooks. These books would include textbooks that may not be available through the Textbook Loan. All theology classes, world language classes, and several other classes are included in this category. ISBN numbers are included on the Book List to help you in ordering these required materials *prior to the beginning of the school year*.

Book fees can be paid at the beginning of the year during the Picnic & Mass Under the Pines on Sunday, August 13th. The Book List document is available on the Mount Michael website for your convenience. If you have questions regarding book fees, please feel free to contact me at the Mount Michael Book Store.
